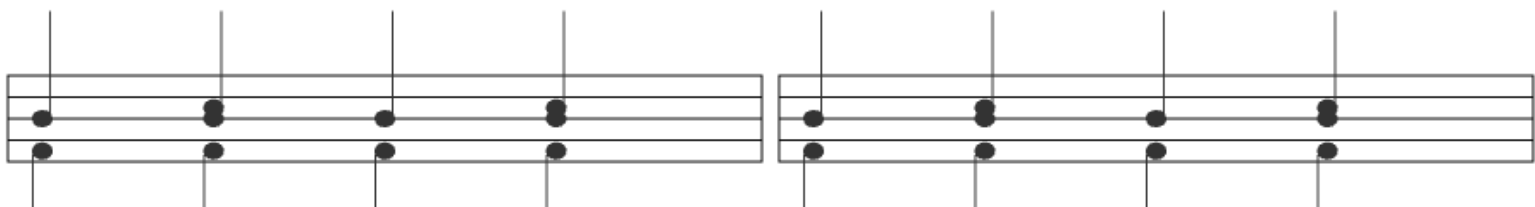

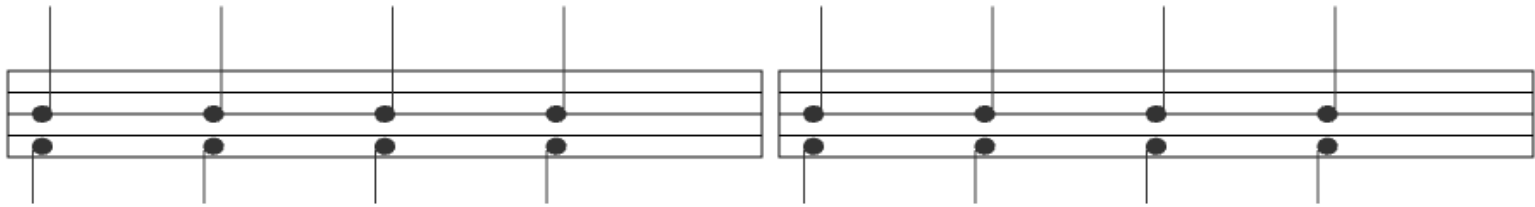
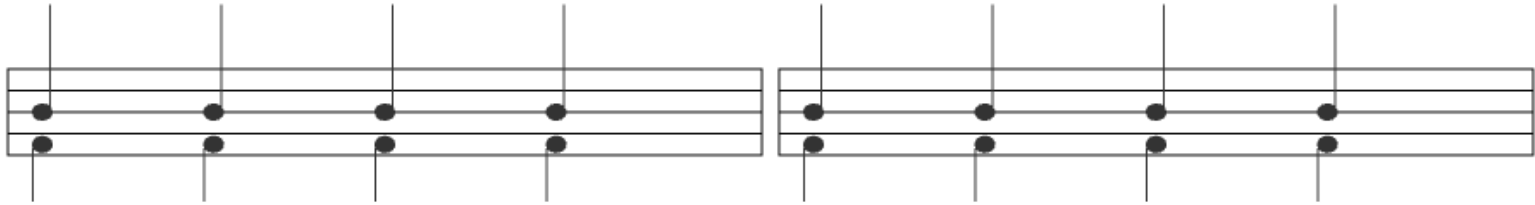
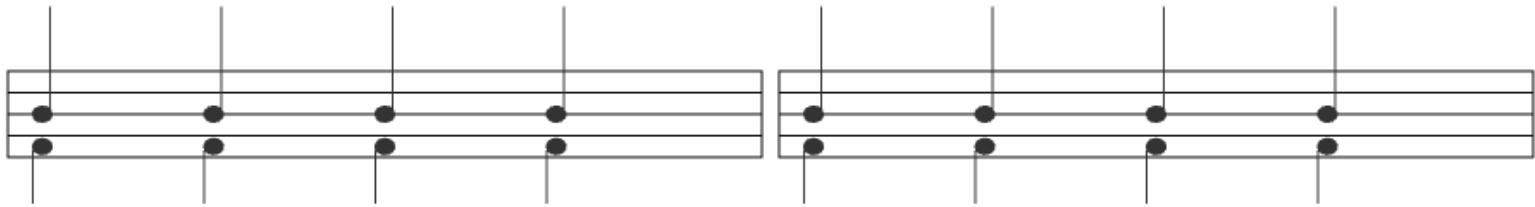

The drum sheet is organized into 7 rows and 2 columns of notation. Each row contains two staves, each with five lines. The notation is as follows:
